

24. Resurvey of Subdivisional Lines in T.36 N., R.62 E.

Chains

80.00 Bell Long Distance Telephone line, bears N.24°30'W., and S.24°30'E.
 80.92 Old corner of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, heretofore described. Corner is 20 ft. above $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
 Land gently rolling.
 South half mile, fine, dry, friable, sandy loam with a little gravel, 1 ft. deep on hardpan. Thence gradually more clay to north until at section corner, damp, cold, plastic red clay with volcanic gravel. No rocks on surface, few red volcanic rocks among soil. No timber. Heavy sagebrush. A little bunchgrass.



SURVEY OF SUBDIVISION OF T. 36 N., R. 62 E.

May 8, 1915. At 8 h 0 m A.M., l.m.t., at the Std.cor. of secs. 34 and 35 on the S. Bdy. of the township, I set off 40°58'N. on the lat. arc; 16°55 $\frac{1}{2}$ 'N. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar.
 Thence I run


N.0°05'W. between secs. 34 and 35.
 Over rolling SW. slope through scattering shadscale and sagebrush.

28.60 Old road, bears N.60°E. and S.60°W.
 35.60 Dry wash, 3 lks. wide, course S.60°W.
 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

54.10 Dry wash, 5 lks. wide, course S.40°W.
 67.30 Road from Wells, to Tobar, Nev., bears S.30°E. and N.30°W.
 80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Land rolling.
 Fine, dry, friable, loose clay and sand with sand predominating. Warm. A little gravel. Post holes show a few small lime stones among soil. Patches of scattering boulders. Washes show coarse gravel and a few boulders of lime stone and quartzite.
 No timber. Sagebrush, white sage and shadscale.

The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34 being plainly visible, I run for said corner

N.89°54'W. on random line for distance only.
 40.00 Set a temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
 80.08 The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.
 Thence I run
 S.89°54'E. on a true line.
 Over level land, through heavy sagebrush.
 40.04 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd:
