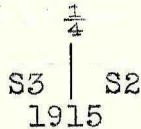


Chains

80.02 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11. Corner is 160 ft. above former section corner.  
 Land rolling.  
 Soil, practically same as the previous mile.  
 Scattering juniper timber with a few pinon pine at extreme east end of mile.  
 Heavy sagebrush and a little grass.

N.0°05'W. on a true line between secs. 2 and 3.  
 Over rolling land, ascend through scattering juniper and pinon pine timber, scrubby sagebrush and a little grass.

16.50 Draw, course W.  
 28.30 Old road, bears N.80°W. and S.80°E.  
 29.70 Old road, bears N.60°E. and S.60°W.  
 37.50 Old road, bears NW. and SE.  
 38.00 Old road, bears E. and W.  
 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:



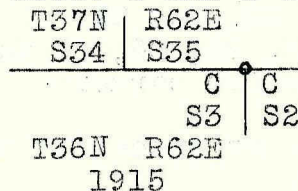
from which:

A cedar 6 ins. in dia. bears N.82°15'E., 177 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$ S2BT.

A cedar 8 ins. in dia. bears N.82°45'W., 40 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$ S3BT.

60.00 Dry wash, 3 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course W.  
 75.20 Rocky ridge, 260 ft. above section corner, bears S.80°W. and N.80°E., 2 chs. E. of line; a cliff 20 ft. high bears N. and S.  
 Descend 90 ft. to township line.

80.55 Intersect N. Bdy. of Tp., 74 lks. S.89°44'E. of the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, T. 37 N., R. 62 E.  
 At the point of intersection, I set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the closing corner of secs. 2 and 3 with a brass cap mkd:



from which:

A pinon pine 10 ins. in dia., bears S.3°E., 67 lks. dist., mkd. T36NR62ES2BT.

A pinon pine 10 ins. in dia. bears S.59°W., 87 lks. dist., mkd. T36NR62ES3BT.

Land, rolling. Heavily rolling at north end.  
 Dense juniper and pinon pine. Stunted sage, and a little grass south of ridge. South end of mile, the soil is same as previous mile. Becomes more rocky to the north. Ridge is very rocky with solid outcrops of volcanic rock.

May 10, 1915.

May 11, 1915: At 9 h o m a.m., l.m.t., at the Std.cor. of secs. 35 and 36 on the S. Bdy. of the township, I set off 40°58'N. on the lat. arc; 17°44'N. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar. Thence I run

N.0°04'W. between secs. 35 and 36.  
 Over rolling west slope through scrubby sage.

33.30 Old road bears N.80°E. and S.80°W.
