Good growth sagebrush, little grass, no timber. Easterly slope.

N 0.2' W bet. secs. 2 and 3

Over somewhat rolling land

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. with brass cap m'kd.

dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of post 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base, 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high W. of cor.

Intersect the 7th. Standard Parallel North at E. 6.40 chs from the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 36N, R. 23E.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 2 and 3 with brass cap m'kd.

Soil, good quality, but somewhat sandy and gravelly. 1st. and 2nd. rate. Good growth sagebrush, little grass, no timber. Slope easterly.
