Chains

Intersect the 7th. Standard Parallel North. at E., 10.41 chs. from the Standard corner of secs. 32 and 33. T.36N. R.23E.
Set a basalt stone, 16x9x9 ins.

11 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 5 and 6, marked c c on the S. face and with 5 grooves on the E. and 1 groove on the W. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high S. of cor.

Land, rolling basalt mountains.

Soil; rocky, unfit for cultivation 4th. rate.

Good growth sagebrush, little grass, no timber.
