

Survey of West bdy. of T. 35 N., R. 23 E.

Chains

Land, rough basalt mountains.
Soil, stony and rocky entirely unfit
for cultivation. Good growth of
sagebrush, little grass, no timber
Drainage easterly.

N. bdy. secs 1 and 6.

5.20 Ridge, bears N.E. and S.W.

22.15 Ravine, course E.

37.10 Ridge, bears N.E. and S.W.

40.00 Set a volcanic stone 15 x 9 x 5 ins.,
10 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face; and raise a
mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high
W. of cor.

47.06 Intersect 7th St. Par. N. at W. 7.84 chs.
from the S.C. for secs. 31 and 32
T. 36 N., R. 23 E.

Set a volcanic stone, 11 x 9 x 8 ins.,
7 ins. in the ground for the C.C. of
T. 35 N., R. 22 and 23 E., marked
C.C. on S.; with 6 grooves on S., E. and
W. faces; and raise a mound of
stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.
Land rough basalt mountains.

Soil stony and rocky, entirely
unfit for cultivation.
Good growth of sagebrush, little
grass, no timber. Drainage north
easterly.

The east bdy. of T. 35 N. R. 23 E.

quality. With irrigation it will
