

Subdivision of T.39½ N., R. 20 E.

Chs.

August 20: At 8 h 15 m A.M., l.m.t., I set off 41°18' on the lat.arc, and 12°36.5'N. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian at the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. Bdy. of the township, described in Book "A". At this corner the magnetic declination is 19°40'E.

Thence I run

N.0°1'W. between secs. 35 and 36.

Over rolling land.

30.80 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 7 ins. deep, course SW.

35.15 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 10 ins. deep, course W.

40.00 Leave rolling, enter mountainous land, bears N.60°E. and S.60°W.; ascend 150 ft. on SE. slope to top of spur.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

59.50 Spur, projects S.65°E.; descend 35 ft. on N. slope to draw.

63.00 Draw, course S.55°E.; ascend 140 ft. on S. slope to top of spur.

76.70 Spur, projects S.70°E.; descend 35 ft. on NE. slope to head of draw.

79.40 Head of draw, course S.70°E.; ascend 5 ft. on S. slope to corner.

80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 15 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

The south 40 chs. of this mile consists of gently rolling land with a southwestern exposure, a fertile gravelly soil, and a good growth of sagebrush. The north 40 chs. consists of mountainous land with a very stony soil and little vegetation. No timber.

East on a random line between secs. 25 and 36.

40.00 Set a temporary ¼ sec. cor.

80.06 Intersect East Bdy. of Tp. 2 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, heretofore described.

Thence I run

N.89°59'W. on a true line between secs. 25 and 36.

Over mountainous land. Along S. slope.

2.00 Descend 500 ft. on SW. slope to wash.

40.03 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 22 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.

50.45 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 10 ins. deep, course S.15°E.; ascend 170 ft. on SE. slope to cor.

80.06 The corner of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.

This mile is on mountainous land draining to the south. The soil is gravelly and stony and unfit for cultivation. There is a fair growth of sagebrush and some bunchgrass. No timber.
