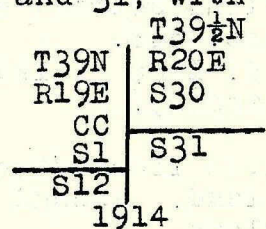


Subdivision of T.39½ N., R. 20 E.

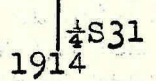
- and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.
- 50.00 Ridge, bears N.20°E., and S.20°W.; descend 50 ft. on NW. slope to head of draw.
- 60.00 Head of draw, course N.15°E.; ascend 50 ft. on NE. slope to top of ridge. Also enter mountain laurel, bears NW. and SE.
- 62.00 Leave mountain laurel, same bearing.
- 69.00 Ridge, bears N. and S.; descend 70 ft. on NW. slope to head of draw.
- 82.00 Sheep corral bears South 4 chs. distant.
- 84.00 Head of draw, course N.; ascend 75 ft. on NE. slope to corner.
- 88.30 Enter aspen timber, bears N. and S.
- 92.80 Leave same, same bearing. NOTE: On account of the presence of innumerable hornets I find it impracticable to blaze the line through this patch of timber.
- 96.69 Intersect the East Bdy. of T.39 N., R. 19 E., at a point 109.01 chs. North of the ¼ sec. cor. on the East Bdy. of sec. 1, and at point of intersection set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 21 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone for the Closing Corner of secs. 30 and 31, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, E. of cor.

This line is on mountainous land. The soil is fertile sandy loam but with a great many rocks in some places. There is a good growth of sagebrush and some bunch-grass. There is also a considerable quantity of aspen timber near the west end of the line and in sight from the line in the north half of sec. 31.

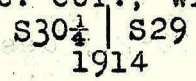
- 40.03 From the Closing Corner of secs. 30 and 31, I run South on a blank line on W. Bdy. of sec. 31. At this point, which is the middle point of the West Bdy. of sec. 31, I set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 13 ins. in the ground, to solid rock and in a mound of stone for ¼ sec. cor., referring to sec. 31, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, E. of cor.

August 25, 1914.

- 10.30 August 26: From the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, I run N.0°4'W. between secs. 29 and 30. Over mountainous land. Ascend 70 ft. on SE. slope. Top of ascent; descend 290 ft. to draw, starting on NE. slope.
- 30.00 Ridge, bears N.30°E. and S.30°W.; slope changes to North.
- 39.90 Service bush on line.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:
