


Subdivision of T.39½ N., R. 20 E.

Chs.

- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

$$\begin{array}{r} S\ 19 \\ \frac{1}{4} \\ \hline S\ 30 \\ 1914 \end{array}$$
- and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.
- 43.00 Draw, course N.20°E.; ascend 175 ft. on E. slope to top of spur.
- 58.30 Spur, projects N.20°E.; descend 15 ft. on NW. slope to draw.
- 65.00 Draw, course N.20°E.; ascend 90 ft. on E. slope to top of spur.
- 72.70 Spur, projects N.20°E.; descend 135 ft. on NW. slope to draw.
- 88.00 Draw, course N.5°E.; ascend 85 ft. on E. slope to closing corner.
- 96.57 Intersect E. Bdy. of Tp. 39 N., R. 19 E. at a point 189.01 chs. North of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., on E. Bdy. Sec. 1, and at point of intersection set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam 24 ins. in the ground for the C.C. of secs. 19 and 30, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, E. of cor.

This line is on mountainous land with a northeasterly slope. The soil of the ridges is very rocky and of the draws a fertile sandy loam. There is a fair growth of sagebrush on the entire line. There are a few scattering mahoganies along the line, but no other timber, though there is much aspen timber up the draw mentioned at 88.00 chs.

- 40.00 From the Closing Corner of secs. 19 and 30, I run South on a blank line on the W. Bdy. of sec. 30. At this point, which is the middle point of the W. Bdy. of sec. 30, I set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 21 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., referring to sec. 30, with a brass cap mkd:

$$\begin{array}{r} \frac{1}{4}S30 \\ 1914 \end{array}$$

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, E. of cor. August 26, 1914.

- October 29: From the cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30, heretofore described, I run N.0°4'W. between secs. 19 and 20. Over mountainous land. Descend 255 ft. on N. slope to Closing Corner.
- 15.00 Draw, course NE.
- 30.00 Same draw, course NW.
- 38.85 Intersect the S. Bdy. of Tp. 40 N., R. 20 E., at a point 26.02 chs. S.89°23'E. of the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, described in Book "B", and at point of intersection set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 23 ins. in the ground to bedrock ^{and} in a mound of stones for Closing
