

## 4. Resurvey of the S. Bdy. T.40 N., R.20 E.

Chs.

at the upper end of the line. There is a fair growth of sagebrush. No timber.

S.1°56'W. on a true line between secs. 33 and 34.  
Over rolling mountainous land. Along W. slope.  
3.00 Descend 285 ft. on SW. slope to draw.  
31.20 Draw, course NW.; ascend 50 ft. on NW. slope.  
39.57 Set a lava stone 15x13x10 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of cor.  
50.00 Top of ascent; thence along W. slope.  
79.14 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.

This line is on rolling mountainous land, sloping W. The soil is rocky and unfit for cultivation. There is a fair growth of sagebrush and some bunchgrass. No timber.

N.89°23'W. on the S. bdy. of sec. 33.  
Over rolling mountainous land. Descend 120 ft. on W. slope to draw.  
9.00 A spring of fresh water bears N. about 4 chs. dist.  
21.00 Draw, course N.; ascend 225 ft. on NE. slope to section corner.  
41.34 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. referring to sec. 33, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.

82.68 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 32 and 33, with a brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.

This mile is on rolling mountainous land, draining toward the draw at 21 chs. from the East end.

The soil is very rocky and unfit for cultivation.

There is a sparse growth of low sagebrush and little else. No timber.

N.89°23'W. on a true line on the S. Bdy. of sec. 32.  
Over rolling mountainous land. Ascend 70 ft. on NE. slope.  
22.00 Top of ascent; descend 25 ft. on NW. slope to draw.  
31.25 Draw, course N.30°E.; ascend 90 ft. on NE. slope to top of spur.  
41.34 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. referring to sec. 32, with brass cap mkd:
