43.00 Top of broad, flat spur, projects N.; descend 50 ft. on
NW. slope to draw.

73.40 Draw, course N.; ascend 100 ft. on NE. slope to corner.

82.68 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in
the ground for the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, with a brass
cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high,
N. of cor.

This line is on rolling mountainous land, with a north-
eastern exposure.

The soil is very rocky and unfit for cultivation.

There is a very sparse growth of low sagebrush and little
else. No timber.

N. $89^{\circ}23'W.$ on the S. Bdy. of sec. 31.

Over rolling mountainous land.

Ascend 120 ft. on NE. slope to top of spur.

21.00 Spur, projects N.; descend 30 ft. on NW. slope to
draw. Also enter scattering mahoganies, bear N. and S.

33.35 Draw, course N. $10^{\circ}E.$; ascend 90 ft. on NE. slope to
top of spur.

41.00 Spur, projects N. $10^{\circ}E.$; descend 65 ft. on NW. slope
to draw.

41.34 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in
the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. referring to sec. 31,
with brass cap mkd:

80.06 The cor. of Ts. 40 N., Rs. 19 and 20 E., heretofore
described.

This line is on rolling mountainous land draining to the
N.

The soil is very rocky and unfit for cultivation.

There is some sagebrush and bunchgrass, also on the W.

$\frac{3}{4}$ of the line scattering mahoganies good for firewood.

From the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, heretofore described,
I run

East on a true line on the S. Bdy. of sec. 34.

Over rolling mountainous land. Ascend 160 ft. on W.
slope to top of ridge.

27.00 Ridge, bears N. and S., descend slightly to draw.

30.85 Draw, course N. Ascend 180 ft. on W. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the
ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
for sec. 34, with brass cap mkd:

80.00 Set a basalt stone $23 \times 13 \times 10$ ins., 17 ins. in the ground
