This township is divided into two fractional parts. Both parts are rough and rocky, they are of granite formation. The soil is a light decomposed sandy clay loam. Vegetation is sagebrush and scattering junipers over the township, but none available for timber.
There is no water in the western fractional part. There are two springs in the N.E. part of the township.

No grazing land in township.

There are no settlers or prospectors in this township, nor is there any surface indications of any mining

being done.

In sections 16 and 17, the Reno Milling Co. has cultivated ten acres of land and put it into wheat and barley. They are testing out the land for dry farming purposes.
