

Resurvey SUBDIVISION OF T.16 N., R.22 E.

Chains

a basalt rock, 18x8x8 ins. above ground, firmly set in a mound of stone, with a mound of stone on the W., mkd. with 5 notches on the S. and 1 notch on the E. edges.

Bearing of last half mile is N89°21'E

Land very rough mountains.

Soil rocky; 4th. rate.

No timber; desert brush scattering.

Mountainous land 80.26 chs.

Thence I continue along same line

East bet. secs. 1 and 12.

15.00 Beginning of gradual ascent over large rocks and boulders.

40.00 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bears S. 1.12 chs., and is a basalt rock 14x10x8 ins. above ground, firmly set in a mound of stone, with a mound of stone N. of same; mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the N. face.

✓ Bearing of last half mile is N89°07'E.

60.00 Top of high ridge, bears N.W. and S.E.; descend steep.

63.25 Bottom of descent and bottom of gulch course, N.W.; ascend steep S.W. slope of high mountain.

76.10 Intersect the E. bdy. of the Tp. 1.20 chs. N. of the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, which is a basalt rock 18x16x12 ins. above ground, firmly set in a mound of stone, with a mound of stone on the W. of same, mkd. with 5 notches on the S. and 1 notch on the N. edges.

Bearing of last half mile is S89°53'E.

Land very rough and mountainous.

Soil rocky; 4th. rate.

No timber; desert brush scattering.

Mountainous land 76.40 chs.

Resurvey of E. Bdy. Sec. 12, T. 16 N. R. 22 E., M. D. M.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, on the E. bdy. of the Tp.

Tp. above described, I run

South on a blank line on the E. bdy. of sec. 12.

Descend very steep over large slide rock boulders.

4.00 Bottom of descent and gulch, course W.; ascend steep.
