Subdivision of T. 22 N., R. 24 E.

Chains

- descend.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:
- $$\begin{array}{r} S\ 27 \\ \frac{1}{4} \\ \hline S\ 34 \\ 1915 \end{array}$$
- and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.
- 43.50 Bottom of draw, 150 ft. below top of spur, course S.10°E.; ascend.
- 45.96 Top of spur, slopes S.; descend.
- 54.92 Bottom of draw, 45 ft. below top of spur, course S.20°W.; ascend. 30 ft. to the closing corner.
- 73.14 Intersect the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation Boundary 11.31 chs. N.21°50'W. of the $12\frac{1}{2}$ mile post, which is a 1 in. iron post set 24 ins. in the ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General. At the point of intersection I build a corner as follows:
- Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the Closing Corner of Secs. 27 and 34, with brass cap mkd:

- and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, E. of cor.
- Land mountainous.
- Soil, rocky clay loam with rocky and gravelly subsoil.
- Vegetation, sagebrush and greasewood.
- No timber. Drainage S.E.
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- N.0°08'E. between secs. 26 and 27.
- Over mountainous land, descend N.W. slope 320 ft. to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:
- $$\begin{array}{r} \frac{1}{4} \\ \hline S27\ S26 \\ 1915 \end{array}$$
- and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
- 44.99 Bottom of canyon, 15 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., course NE.; ascend 360 ft. to the section corner.
- 56.98 Draw, course NE.
- 80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone for the cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27, with brass cap mkd:
- $$\begin{array}{cc|cc} T22N & R24E & & \\ S22 & S23 & & \\ \hline S27 & S26 & & \\ 1915 & & & \end{array}$$
- and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
- Land mountainous.
- Soil, gravelly and rocky clay loam; subsoil the same.
- Vegetation, sheep brush, sagebrush, greasewood and scattering growth of bunchgrass.
- No timber. Poor grazing.
- At this corner I set off 16°07'N. on the decl. arc and at about 11 h 57 m a.m., l.m.t., observe the sun on the meridian. The resulting latitude is 39°44'N.
