#### General Description.

This fractional township has rough and mountainous land along the east, north, west, and part of the south boundaries. The land in the remainder of the township is rolling and broken.

The mountains are nearly all of volcanic formation, except a small portion on the north boundary, which is of granite formation. The surface of the rolling and broken ground is covered with large lava rocks.

The soil in this township is mostly a shallow clay loam, rocky and gravelly, with a deep sand over the rolling ground.

There is no timber in the township, and the only vegetation is a scanty growth of rabbitbrush, greasewood, and a little sagebrush. There is no grazing land in this township.

There are no settlers, no prospectors, no surface indications of any mineral, and no water in this township.
