May 15: At this township corner I set off 18°46'N. on the decl. arc, and at 11 h 56 m a.m., l.m.t., observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude is 39°37'.

RETRACEMENT OF WEST BDY. T.21 N., R. 25 E.

From the cor. of T. 21 N., Rs. 24 and 25 E., above described, I run
N.0°6'W. retracing between secs. 31 and 36.
39.98 Fall 366 lks. E. of the ¼ sec. cor., which is a lava stone 8x10x12 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General. Therefore the true course and distance of this half mile is N.5°20'W., 40.15 chs.
From my transit station 366 lks. E. of the ¼ sec. cor., I continue N.0°06'W.
80.00 Fall 7 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, which is a lava stone 6x8x6 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
Therefore the true course and distance of this half mile is N.5°02'E., 40.17 chs.

May 29: For solar see line between secs. 29 and 30 of Subdivisions.
From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the West Bdy. heretofore described, I run
N.0°6'W., retracing between secs. 25 and 30.
40.00 After a careful search no trace of the ¼ sec. cor. could be found.
80.20 Fall 52 lks. W. of the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, heretofore described.
Therefore the true course and distance of this mile is N.0°16'E., 80.20 chs.

Thence I run
S.0°16'W. resurveying between secs. 25 and 30.
Over mountainous land.
2.00 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, in canyon, course SW. Ascend 140 ft.
15.75 Spur, projects SW., descend.
34.00 Draw, 345 ft. below spur, course S.20°W.
Continue gradual descent along E. side of draw.
40.10 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

S25¼ S30

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.
45.00 Leave mountainous and rocky land, enter rolling sandy land bears E. and W.
80.20 The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36.
The N. 45 chs. is mountainous, with a general S.W. exposure and drainage; soil, rocky 4th rate.
The S. 35.20 chs. is rolling, drainage to the west; soil, deep, loose sandy.
Undergrowth, scattering greasewood and sagebrush on the mile.
No timber.
