

Chains

S.89°56'E., on a random line between secs. 3 and 10.  
40.00 Set a temporary  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
79.80 Fall 2 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.  
Thence I run  
N.89°55'W. on a true line between secs. 3 and 10.  
Over mountainous land.  
Ascend along N. side of canyon, facing nearly S.  
20.00 Top of ascent on N. side of canyon, bears N. and S.;  
descend.  
31.70 Bottom of main canyon, course S.60°E.  
36.90 N. point of rocky spur, bears S.10°W.  
39.90 650 ft. above section corner.  
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 20 ins.  
in the ground to bed rock and in a mound of stone for  
the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:  
$$\begin{array}{r} \frac{1}{4} \\ S \quad 3 \\ \hline S \quad 10 \\ 1915 \end{array}$$
  
and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high,  
N. of cor.  
Continue ascent over E. face of the mountain.  
45.60 Canyon, course N.75°E.  
69.00 Top of main high ridge, 1625 ft. above section corner,  
bears N.10°W. and S.10°E., descend 115 ft. to  
79.80 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.  
Land, rough mountain with a general face to the E. on the  
E. 69 chs., and to the SW. on the W. 11 chs.  
Soil, rocky of volcanic formation, 4th rate.  
Undergrowth, sage and bunchgrass.  
No timber.

June 1: For solar observation see line between secs.  
2 and 3.  
N.0°05'W. on a true line between secs. 3 and 4.  
Over high, rough mountainous land; ascend 255 ft. to  
17.55 W. 50 lks. of top of high rocky peak, from which  
main ridge bears N.30°E. and S.20°E.; descend nearly  
N. slope.  
38.80 Ledge, 20 ft. high, bears N.80°W., 2 chs. and S.80°E.,  
1 ch. dist.  
40.00 On N. slope, 425 ft. below peak.  
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 14 ins.  
in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone  
for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:  
$$\begin{array}{r} \frac{1}{4} \\ S4 \quad S3 \\ \hline 1915 \end{array}$$
  
and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high,  
W. of cor.  
43.20 Canyon, 50 ft. below corner, course N.W.; ascend 160 ft.  
59.50 Top of ascent, bears NW. and SE.; descend 130 ft. to  
73.92 Intersect the N. bdy. of the township, S.89°46'E.,  
2.62 chs., from the old corner of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34,  
heretofore described.  
At point of intersection I set an iron post 3 ft. long,  
2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the closing  
corner of secs. 3 and 4, with brass cap mkd:
