

RETRACEMENT OF THE WEST BOUNDARY OF T.23 N., R.26 E.

Chains

Thence, I retrace North along the same line bet. secs.  
1 and 6.

Descend gradually.

94.13 Cor. of Tps. 23 and 24 N., Rs. 25 and 26 E., a granite  
stone 16x14x8 ins. above ground, with mound of stone,  
on the south side, mkd with 6 notches on the N.; 6  
notches and T24N R26E on the E.; 6 notches on the S.;  
6 notches and T23N R25E on the W. sides, bears E. 77lks.  
Course, N0°05'E  
Land rolling.  
Soil sandy.  
No timber; desert brush.

The south mile of this line runs over extremely high mountains

rolling land. The soil is mostly sandy. There is no  
vegetation except a low desert brush. There is no
