


Subdivision of T25N, R26E

Chains.

- 30.00 Mountain ridge, brass C. and W.
- 39.10 Head of ravine, course N.E.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. with brass cap m'kd.




dig pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. N. and S. of post 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth, 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base, 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high W. of cor.

- 42.00 Mountain spur, slopes E.
- 58.10 Ravine, course N.E.

Mountain spur, slopes N.E.

Deep ravine, course E.

86.10 Intersect the 5th Standard Parallel North at S89.50E, 9.34 chs. from the standard cor. of sec. 33 and 34, re-established by me October 3, 1911. Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of sec. 3 and 4, with brass cap m'kd.



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high S. of cor.

Land, rolling granite mountains. Soil, gravelly, sandy and rocky. 4th rate. Unfit for cultivation. Much quartz float and outcropping of quartz ledges. Good mineral indications. Good growth sagebrush, little grass, no timber. Slopes easterly. November 3, 1911.
