timber. Slopes easterly.

W. on a true line bet. secs. 6 and 7.

Over high rolling granite mountains.

12.00 High mountain divide, bears N.E. and S.W.

30.40 Ravine, course S.W.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam.  
24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
with brass cap mkd.

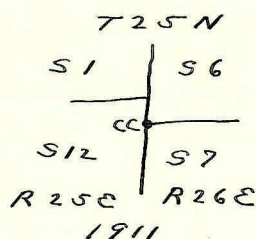
dig pits 18x18x12 ins E. and W. of post  
3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth

67.00 Ridge, bears N.E. and S.W.

79.09 Intersect the W. bdy. of the tp. at S.  
13.78 chs. from the cor. of secs. 1 and 12,  
established by me. Sept. 26, 1911.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins.  
diam. 24 ins. in the ground for  
closing corner of secs. 6 and 7, with

dig pits 24x18x12 ins. crosswise on each
