General Description.

The eastern part of this township is level land with a fairly uniform easterly slope. The soil on this portion is a good, deep, sandy, loam; derived from the disintegration of granite rocks. If it could be irrigated it would be very fertile and productive, there is no water available at the present time for irrigation, and without it the land is practically valueless. The rest of the township is granite mountains, in some places there is quartz float and good mineral indications, but outside of this it is of little value. The only water is Blue Wing spring in sec. 22. There are no settlers in this township.
