

## RETRACEMENT OF THE EAST BDY. OF T.22 N., R.27 E.

Chains

of the Badger lode, U.S. Survey N. 37 bears  $S78^{\circ}25'E$   
13.55 chs.

I continue my line

North on the E. bdy. of sec. 1.

38.90 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. bears W. 20 lks., and is a sandstone  $16 \times 11 \times 4$  ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face.

✓ The bearing of last half mile is  $N.0^{\circ}22'E$ .

78.30 The Tp. cor. of Tps. 22 and 23 N., Rs. 27 and 28 E. bears E. 6 lks., and is an igneous rock,  $8 \times 6 \times 3$  ins. loosely set in a small mound of stone, which I reestablished at the same point. (see field notes of resurvey of N. bdy. of this Tp.)

✓ The bearing of the last half mile is  $N0^{\circ}22'E$ .

The bearing of the E. bdy. of the Tp. from the S.E. to the N.E. cor thereof is  $N00^{\circ}00'E$ . 484.62 chs.

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
