78.30 The Tp. cor. of Tps. 22 and 23 N., Rs. 27 and 28 E. bears E. 6 lks., and is an igneous rock, 8x6x3 ins. loosely set in a small mound of stone, which I reestablished at the same point. (see field notes of resurvey of N. bdy. of this Tp.)

The bearing of the last half mile is NO°22'E.

The bearing of the E. bdy. of the Tp. from the S.E. to the N.E. cor thereof is NOO°OO'E. 484.62 chs.
