## Chains

and dig pits 18x18x12 ins. E. and W. of post 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high N. of cor.

41.00 Top of ridge, bears N. and S. Desc.

80.14 Cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30.

Land hilly.

Soil, a deep sand.

Scattering desert brush.

Sept. 4: At this cor. I set off  $7^{\circ}24'N.$  on the decl. arc, and at noon observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting lat. is  $39^{\circ}44'N.$

Knowing that I will not close within limits, I run West on a random line bet. secs. 19 and 30.

40.00 Set a temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

76.08 Intersect the W. Bdy. of the Tp. 52 lks. S.  $0^{\circ}3'W.$  of the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, which is an igneous rock 12x10x10 ins. surrounded by a mound of stone mkd. with 4 notches on the N. and 2 notches on the S. sides.

At the point of intersection I set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for the closing cor. of secs. 19 and 30, marked on brass cap:

and dig pits 24x18x12 ins. crosswise on each line N. and S. 3 ft., and E. of post 7 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high E. of cor.

Thence from the CC I run

East on a true line bet. secs. 19 and 30

36.08 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 26 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked on brass cap:

76.08 The cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30.

Land heavily rolling.

Soil, a deep sand.

Scattering sagebrush.

N.  $0^{\circ}03'W.$  bet. secs. 19 and 20.

Asc. over heavily rolling land.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 26 ins. in ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked on brass cap:

65.00 Top of ridge, bears NE and SW. Desc. abruptly.

77.00 Gulch, 200 ft. deep, course SW.

80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in ground for cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20, marked on brass cap:
