Chains.	Sept. 6, 1911: At 8 h 0 m l.m.t., I set off $39^{\circ} 48' N.$ on the lat. arc, $6^{\circ} 44' N.$ on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian at the cor. of Tps. 22 and 23 N., Rs. 26 and 27 E., Thence I run N. bet. secs. 31 and 36. Over rolling land.
38.03	Old C.P.R.R. grade, bears NE. and SW.
39.72	The $1/4$ cor. bet. secs. 31 and 36. A stone $16 \times 10 \times 4$ ins. in a mound of stone, marked $1/4$ on W face, bears E. 9 lks. dist. The course of this line is $N. 0^{\circ} 8' E.$
58.00	Wash 100 lks. wide, course SW., asc. over rolling land.
80.00	Cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36. A stone $17 \times 12 \times 4$ ins. in a mound of stone marked with one notch on S. and 5 notches on N. edges, bears E. 18 lks. Land rolling. Soil, a heavy sand mixed with gravel. Scattering desert brush. The course of this line is $N. 0^{\circ} 8' E.$

	Thence from the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36 I run N. bet. secs. 25 and 30. Asc. over rolling land.
40.02	The $1/4$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 25 and 30. A stone $14 \times 10 \times 6$ ins. in a mound of stone marked $1/4$ on W. face, bears E. 6 lks. Course of this line $N. 0^{\circ} 5' E.$
80.30	Cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30. A stone $10 \times 12 \times 4$ ins. in a mound of stone marked with 2 notches on S. and 4 notches on N. edges, bears E. 17 lks. Land rolling. Soil, a heavy sand mixed with gravel. Scattering desert brush. Course of this line $N. 0^{\circ} 9' E.$

	Thence from the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, I run N. bet. secs. 19 and 24. Ascend over rolling hills.

24.00	Draw, course SW. asc.
40.09	The $1/4$ cor. bet. secs. 19 and 24. A stone $14 \times 10 \times 4$ ins. in a mound of stone marked $1/4$ on W. face, bears E. 9 lks. The course of this line is $N. 0^{\circ} 8' E.$
80.10	Cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24. A stone $16 \times 8 \times 6$ ins. in a mound of stone, marked with 3 notches on N. and 3 notches on S. edges, bears E. 17 lks. Land, heavily rolling. Soil, a heavy sand mixed with gravel. Scattering desert brush. The course of this line is $N. 0^{\circ} 07' E.$

	Thence from the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24. I run N. bet. secs. 13 and 18. Over rolling hills Draining to SW.
40.24	The $1/4$ cor. bet. secs. 13 and 18. A malpais $12 \times 4 \times 4$ ins. in a mound of stone, marked $1/4$ on W. face, bears E. 8 lks. The course of this line is $N. 0^{\circ} 7' E.$

76.00	Top of W. slope, desc.
80.06	Cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18. A stone $24 \times 16 \times 12$ ins. in a mound of stone marked with 4 notches on S. and 2 notches on N. edges, bears E. 18 lks. Land rolling hills. Soil, a heavy sand and gravel.
