

Subdivision of T.24 N., R. 27 E.

7.

Chains

Land rolling.
Soil, sand mixed with gravel; 3rd rate.
No timber, desert brush.

N.0°03'W. on a true line bet. secs. 5 and 6.
Descend gently over rolling land.

1.60 Dry wash, 10 lks. wide, course SE.

12.75 Top of low ridge, 30 ft. high, bears NE. and SW., descend.

30.00 Descend into Sage Hen flat bears E. and W.

35.20 Sage Hen Creek, dry, 50 lks. wide, course E.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

and dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of the post, 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

48.00 Leave Sage Hen flat; ascend.


54.00 Top of ascent; thence descend gently over rolling land.

58.00 Dry wash, 20 lks. wide, course E.

71.80 Dry wash 20 lks. wide, course NE.

81.11 Intersect the N. bdy. of the township, 6.30 chs. S.89° 20'W. from the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, heretofore described. At the point of intersection I

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd:




and dig pits 24x18x12 ins., crosswise on each line E. and W. 3 ft. and S. of post 7 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

From the closing corner above described, I run N.89°20'E. bet. secs. 5 and 32.

6.30 The cor. of secs. 31 and 32, heretofore described.

40.09 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 5, with brass cap mkd:




and dig pits 18x18x12 ins. E. and W. of post, 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

From the same closing corner above described, I run S.89°20'W. bet. secs. 6 and 31.

33.70 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31, heretofore described.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6, with brass cap mkd:



dig pits 18x18x12 ins. E. and W. of the post, 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

Land heavily rolling.
Soil, sandy and gravelly.
No timber, desert brush.
