

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

With the exception of the E. tier of sections, this township all contains mountainous land, very rough. The soil is principally rock strewn and solid rock, totally unfit for cultivation, in any part of the township.

The vegetation consists of a more or less scattered growth of desert brush. There is no timber of any description in the township.

Other than the springs mentioned in the foregoing field notes there is no water in the Township. There are mineral indications in secs. 27, 28 33 and 34, which might lead to substantial values if developed.

There are no settlers in the Tp.
