Chains

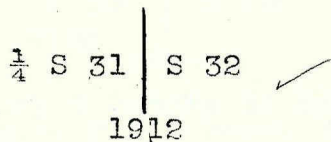
July 12, 1912.

Beginning at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32 on the S. bdy. of the township, at 8 h., a. m., l. m. t., I set off 22° N. on the decl. arc and 40° 10' N. on the lat. arc and determine a meridian with the solar; thence I run

North on a sectional guide meridian bet. secs. 31 and 32. Desc. over rolling land.

20.00 Foot of descent, enter level land, bears E. and W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., with a brass cap, marked



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

40.90 Dry wash, 10 lks. wide, course SE., asc.

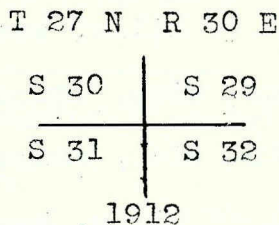
47.30 Top of low hill, bears NE. and SW., desc.

49.50 Gully, 12 lks. wide, course S. 75° E., asc.

54.10 Top of low ridge, bears E. and W., desc.

68.50 Dry wash, 50 lks. wide, course S. 20° E., asc.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, with a brass cap, marked



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Surface rolling.

Soil sandy and gravelly, 3rd. rate.

No undergrowth.

Drains SE.
