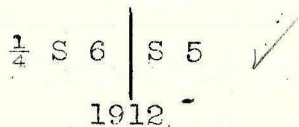
At 9 h., a. m., l. m. t., I set off $21^{\circ} 32'$ N. on the decl. arc and $40^{\circ} 15'$ N. on the lat. arc and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8; thence I run

North on a sectional guide meridian bet. secs. 5 and 6. Asc. over rolling land.

24.75 Asc. abruptly.

26.40 Top of spur, bears E. and W., desc.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with a brass cap, marked



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor.

40.20 Gully, 5 lks. wide, course E., asc.

59.50 Top of ridge, bears E.

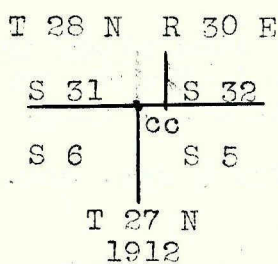
69.30 E. slope of cliff rock, bears N. and S., desc.

74.60 Gully, 10 lks. wide, course SE., asc.

79.00 Top of ridge, bears E. and W., desc.

81.46 Intersect N. bdy. of the township 3.92 chs. W. of the cor. of secs. 31 and 32.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam. 5 ins. in the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone for closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with a brass cap, marked



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.
