General Description.

This township is rough and mountainous in the central and northwest portions, and rolling in the southwest and southern parts. The soil in the southwest portion is in general a rich, volcanic ash loam, gravelly and very deep; first and second rate soil. This land under irrigation would be very suitable for agriculture. The remaining portion of the land, except in the small valleys along the washes, is rocky and on an average has been classed as a third rate soil.
