The eastern half of this township is rough and mountainous, the soil being rocky and in general of third rate classification. The east boundary of the township follows closely along the main divide of Trinity range of mountains for nearly four miles, whence the divide bears east into range 31. The land of the west half varies from rough rolling to table land, which has a general slope to the west. The soil of the west and northwest sections is a rich gravelly loam, and can nearly all be classed as first and second rate. Irrigation would be necessary for the growing of crops within this township. There is a scattering growth of bunch grass in the mountainous portions, which
