

Subdivision of T. 31N. R. 30E.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam.,
24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.,
with brass cap mkd.;

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,
 $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

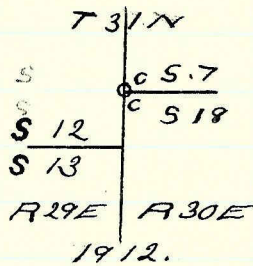
51.00 Bottom of deep gulch, course S.S.W.; ascend.

60.50 Top of S. end of ridge, bear N. and S.; descend.

66.00 Bottom of gulch, course S.E.

78.32 Intersect W. bdy. 84 lks. N. of the cor. of
secs. 12 and 13, T. 31N. R. 29E, heretofore described.

I destroy markings on old cor. referring to T. 31N.,
R. 30E., and at point of intersection, I set
an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 in. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, for C. C. of secs. 7 and 18,
with brass cap mkd.;



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$
ft. high, E. of cor.

From the C. C. of secs. 7 and 18, above described
I run

N. $0^{\circ}4'$ E. on the W. bdy. of sec. 7.

40.40 Set a granite stone, 16X12X10 ins., 11 ins.
in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 7,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on E. face; and raise a
mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high,
E. of cor.

Land mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 4th rate.

No timber; undergrowth, desert brush.
