

Survey of the West Boundary of T. 32 N., R. 30 E.

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1912

- dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth, 3 1/2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.
- 40.40 Point on bridge of Placeritas workings, bears N. 22° 42' E.; and well bears N. 47° 35' E.
- 48.78 Road, bears E. and W.
- 52.00 Enter rolling hills; ascend.
- 54.60 Road, bears N. E. and S. W.
- 64.69 Point on bridge of Placeritas workings, bears N. 47° 52' E.; well bears N. 87° 47' E.
- 77.00 Top of ascent.
- 80.18 Intersect the closing cor. for T. 32 N., R. 29 and 30 E., heretofore described.
- Sand, gently rolling and rolling hills.
Soil, clay, sand and gravel; 3rd. rate.
No timber; undergrowth, desert brush.
Rolling hills, 28.18 chs.
- Sept. 5, 1912.

Subdivision of T. 32 N., R. 30 E.

- Sept. 5, 1912: At 7⁰⁰ a.m. l.m.t., I set off 40° 35' N. on the lat. arc; 6° 51' N. on the decl. arc; and determine a true meridian with the solar, at the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35, and 36 on the S. bdy., heretofore described.
- Thence I run N. 0° 1' W., between secs. 35 and 36.
Over rolling land.
- 11.00 Top of low spur, bears E. and W.
- 26.00 Top of low spur, bears W. and E.; descend gradual N. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 2 1/2 in. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.;
