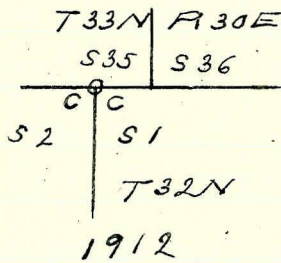


Subdivision of T. 32 N., R. 30 E.

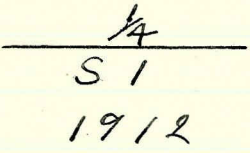
- and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.
- 45.00 Bottom of deep gulch, course W.; ascend.
- 57.00 Top of spur, bears W. and E.; descend.
- 64.00 Bottom of deep gulch, course W.; ascend.
- 75.00 Top of rocky spur, bears W. and E.; descend.
- 78.78 Intersect N. bdy. of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec., 25.45 chs. westward of the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 33 N., R. 30 E.

At pt. of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap mkd.;
