General Description.

The southwestern and northeastern portion of the township is rough mountainous. The remainder of the township is principally rolling, the drainage being mainly to the northwest.

There is no timber in the township, except in the extreme northeast portion, where there are stunted junipers. The other vegetation is stunted desert brush. The soil is a mixture of clay, sand and gravel, and near the mountainous parts, is thickly strewn with rock.

The formation of all the mountainous parts of the township is volcanic. In the extreme northeast portion, there are many outcroppings of granite and quartz. The soil in the northwest portion of the township contains placer gold. Placitas, a small placer mine, is located on the north boundary of sec. 6.

There is no water in the township except the well in sec. 6. This well is fortyfive feet deep and has an abundance
