General Description.

The surface of this fractional township is broken, being almost wholly covered with high, rugged mountains, cut with deep canyons. The drainage is principally to the west.

There is no timber in the township, the only vegetation being stunted desert brush. The soil, where there is any, is a mixture of clay, sand and gravel, mostly thickly strewn with rock.

The mountains are principally schist and volcanic, with many quartz outcroppings. There are good mineral indications.

The only water in the township is the spring near the south west cor. of sec. 13. There are no settlers in the township.
