## General Description.

This fract. township lies on the West side of the Humboldt River valley. Part of sec. 30 and part of sec. 20 are under irrigation, soil very productive and alfalfa grows and produces well. Sec. 19 is considerable higher and rolling. Lone mountain is in the west part of sec. 20, a hill about 1.000 ft. above the valley. There are no indications of mineral. Two roads from Lovelock to the mining district of Seven Troughs cross the fraction, also a telephone line.
