

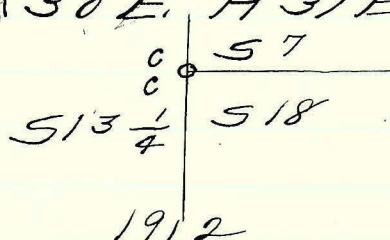
Subdivision of T. 30 N., R. 31 E.

R. 31 E., previously described.
At the point of intersection
I build a cor. as follows:
Set an iron post 3 ft. long,
2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in
the ground for closing cor.
of secs. 7 and 18 with brass
cap miked. T30N.

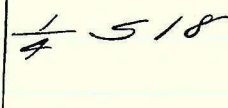
dig pits 24 x 18 x 12 ins. crosswise
