Chains

1.40 Bottom of gulch, course E.; ascend.

7.00 Top of E. end of ridge, bears W.S.W. Descend.

14.00 Draw, course E.; ascend.

21.00 Top of ascent, bears E. and W.; descend.

27.00 Draw, course N.E.

40.00 Set an iron post. 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.;
