 No timber; undergrowth, desert brush.

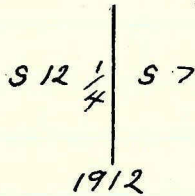
North, bet. secs. 7 and 12.

 with brass cap mkd.;

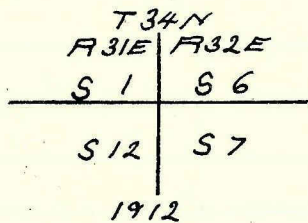
