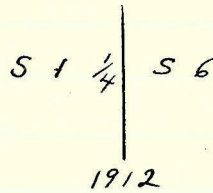


Resurvey of the East Boundary of T. 34N, R. 31E.

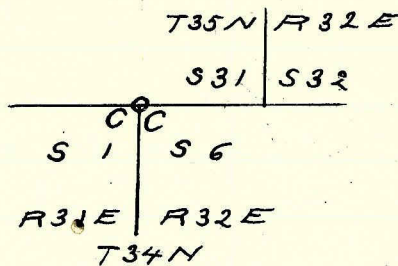
Old road, bears N.E. and S.W.

Sand, practically level.

No timber; undergrowth, desert brush.

Survey of the North Boundary of T. 34N, R. 31E.

Oct. 28, 1912: At 9^h 00^m a. m. l. m. t., I set off 40° 50' N. on the lat. arc; 13° 8' S on the decl. arc; and determine a true meridian with the solar, at the closing cor. of T. 34N, Rs. 31 and 32 E., above described. Thence I run S. 89° 39' W., on the N. bdy. of sec. 1.
