


Survey of the West Boundary of T. 34 N., R. 31 E.

Subdivision of T. 34 N., R. 31 E.


Oct. 12, 1912: At 9°08' a.m. l.m.t., I set
off $40^{\circ}45'N$. on the lat. arc; and $7^{\circ}25'S$.
on the decl. arc; and determine a true
meridian with the solar, at the cor. of
secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. boundary
heretofore described.

Thence I run

$N. 0^{\circ}1'W$, bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over rolling land, with slight N.E. slope.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam.,
24 in. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.,
with brass cap mkd.;



dig pit, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of post,
3 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth,
3½ ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Old sheep corral bears W. 3 chs.
