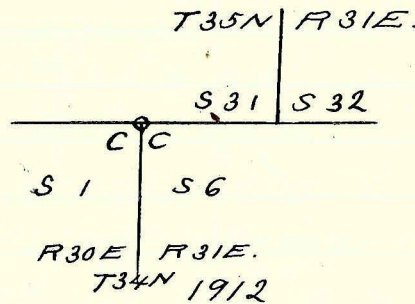


Survey of the West Boundary of T. 34 N., R. 31 E.

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,
1½ ft. high, S. of cor.From cor., Sawtooth mining camp, bears S. 20° 30' E.
South side center post of Deer Park Lodge, bears
S. 32° 45' W., 6.84 chs.J. here

Subdivision of T. 34 N., R. 31 E.

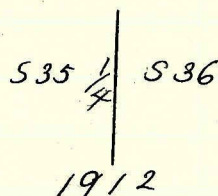
Oct. 12, 1912: At 9⁰⁰ a.m. l.m.t., I set
off 40° 45' N. on the lat. arc; and 7° 25' S.
on the decl. arc; and determine a true
meridian with the solar, at the cor. of
secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy.
heretofore described.

Thence I run

N. 0° 1' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over rolling land, with slight N.E. slope.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam.,
24 in. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor.,
with brass cap mkd.;dig pits, 18 X 18 X 12 ins., N. and S. of post,
3 ft. dist; and raise a mound of earth,
