

General Description.

The surface of this township, is broken, being almost wholly covered with high, rugged mountains, cut with deep canyons. The highest mountains are near the central part of the township, thus causing the drainage to be in all directions.

There is no timber in the township, the only vegetation being stunted desert brush. The soil is a mixture of clay, sand and gravel, mostly thickly strewn with rock. The soil in the southeast portion, is decomposed granite.

The mountains are principally granite, with many outcroppings of quartz. The mining camp shown in sec. 6, is now deserted.

The only water in the township is the four small springs shown on the plat, and a well at the mining camp. There are no settlers in the township.
