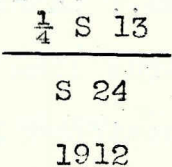


Subdivision of fracl. T. 26 N., R. 32 E.

Chains East on a true line bet. secs. 13 and 24.
 Asc. over rough mountainous land.
 18.00 Asc. abruptly.
 36.00 Top of main mt. range, 6000 ft. alt., bears N. and S.,
 desc.
 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 20 ins. in
 the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec.
 cor., with a brass cap, marked



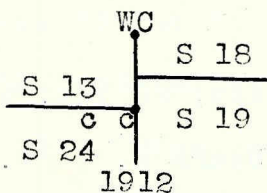
Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of
 cor. 0° 4' W.

76.90 Intersect E. bdy. of tp. 2.12 chs. S. \wedge of the cor. of
 secs. 18 and 19.

Point for closing cor. at point of intersection falls
 in a dry wash in gully, unsafe for cor., therefore
 at a point 30 lks.N. of point of intersection

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 14 ins. in
 the ground to bedrock in a mound of stone for wit-
 ness closing cor. of secs. 13 and 24, with a brass
 cap, marked
