

Resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 27 N., R. 32 E.

Chains	Oct. 12th., 1912.
	I begin at the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the township, which is a granite stone 7 X 10 X 12 ins. above ground; marked with 3 grooves on E. and W. faces and set in a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, 1½ ft. high.
	At 8h., 45m. a.m., l.m.t. I set off 7°25½' S. on the decl. arc and 40°9' N. on the lat. arc and determine a meridian with the solar: thence I retrace East on a random line along the S. bdy. of sec. 34.
40.00	Intersect a point 15 lks. N. of the original ¼ sec. cor. which is a quartz rock 15 X 18 X 20 ins. in diam., marked ¼ on N. face and set in a stone mound, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high.
	I continue same line east and at.
80.00	Intersect a point 31 lks. N. of the original cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 which is a pine post 3½ ins. square and 30 ins. above ground, marked with 2 grooves on E. and 4 grooves on W. faces and set in a mound of earth.
	N. 89°47' W. on a true line on the S. bdy. of sec. 34. Desc. over rough mountainous land covered with loose boulders.
10.00	Canon and dry wash, 45 lks. wide, course SW. asc.
22.40	Top of S. slope of spur, bears SW. desc.
32.00	Canon and dry wash, 1 ch. wide, course S 70° W. asc.
38.10	Dry wash, 1 ch. wide, course S. 60° W. asc.
40.00	¼ sec. cor. on S. side of sec. 34.
65.00	Top of S. slope of spur, bears SW. desc.
80.00	Cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34.
	Surface rough mountainous.
	No soil, barren rocks.
	No undergrowth.
	Drains SW.
	80.00 chs. mountains.
