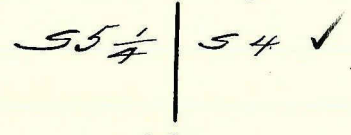


Subdivision of fractl. T. 30 N., R. 32 E.

Chains  
 71.50 Top of spur, bearing  $5.20^{\circ} E$  and North, descend  
 75.00 Wash, 20 lbs. wide, course  $5.20^{\circ} E$ . ascend along side of draw.  
 80.00 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9  
 Land, mountainous  
 Soil, rocky; 3<sup>d</sup> rate  
 Undergrowth, sage and desert brush.  
 No timber.  
 Mountainous land, 80.00 chains.

No<sup>s</sup> 1 W. but a true line bet.  
 secs. 4 and 5  
 Over mountainous land; descend  
 1.50 Wash, 20 lbs. wide course East.  
 8.00 Top of spur, projecting East; desc.  
 11.00 Wash, 20 lbs. wide, course  $5.20^{\circ} E$ ; asc.  
 over rolling land.  
 39.00 Wash, 10 lbs. wide course  $5.80^{\circ} E$ ; asc.  
 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in.

 for  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of secs. 4 and 5 with  
 brass cap mtd.;

79.60 Intersect sixth standard parallel North;
