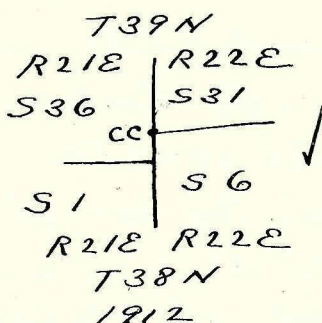


Chains.

the cor. of Tps. 38 and 39 N, Rs. 21 and 22 E. at N. 10.70 chs. from this corner. Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for closing the cor. of Tps. 38 and 39 N, Rs. 21 and 22 E. with brass cap mkd.



dig pits 30 x 24 x 12 ins; crosswise on each line, N. and S. 4 ft. and E. of post 8 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth 5 ft. base, 2 1/2 ft. high E. of cor.

Land, somewhat rolling.

Soil, gravelly loam of no great depth. 2nd. rate.

Good growth sagebrush, little grass, no timber, S. E. slope.

I efface the notches on the E. edge of the corner of Tps. 38 and 39 N, Rs. 21 and 22 E, and destroying all traces of the accessories charge them to pits 30 x 24 x 12 ins. on each line N. and S. 4 ft., and W. of stone 8 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 5 ft. base, 2 1/2 ft. high W. of cor. thus changing it to a corner for Tps. 38 and 39 N, R21E.
