

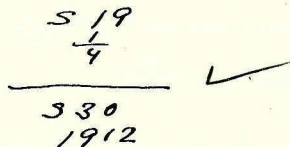
Chains.

76.00 Descend westerly slope, steep and rocky
Foot of mountain, thence across level land.
80.10 The cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30.
Land, rocky volcanic mountains and level.
Soil, rocky and good desert loam, 4th.
and 1st. rate.
E. 76.00 cho. is rocky mountains, entirely
unfit for cultivation.
W. 4.10 cho. is level land with good desert
loam soil several feet in depth, 1st. rate.
On entire distance is good growth sage-
brush, little grass, no timber.

W. on a true line bet. secs. 19 and 30
Over level land.

8.50 Dry bed of Cottonwood creek, course N.E.
16.00 Leave level land, ascend rolling mountains
25.40 Low mountain spur, slopes S.E.
40.00 On S.E. slope

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam.
24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
with brass cap mked



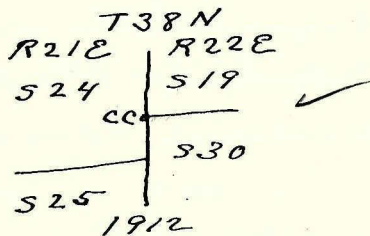
and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base
 $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high N. of cor.

47.15 Ravine, course S.E.

68.00 Ridge, bears N. and S.

69.35 Intersect W. ldy. of tp. at N020E, 12.85 cho.
from the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam.
24 ins. in the ground for closing corner
of secs. 19 and 30, with brass cap mked.



dig pits 24 x 18 x 12 ins. crosswise on each
line N. and S., 3 ft. and E. of post 7 ft. dist.
