Over high rolling volcanic mountains.

3.50 Top of mountain, bear N. and S.

18.10 Ravine Course N.E.

40.00 On N.E. slope

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam.  
24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
with brass cap inked.

way between the closing corner of sec.
