

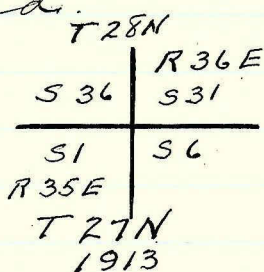
Resurvey of East Bdy of T 27N, R 35E.
(Humboldt River Guide Meridian)

chains

As the two townships have not been subdivided, I resurvey the range line between them, as follows:-

The old cor. of Tps 27 and 28 N, Rs. 35 and 36 E., is a post nearly all decayed, and the marks are obliterated. I destroy all traces of the old cor and reestablish it at the same point as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft long, 3 ins. in diam. 24 ins in the ground, for cor to Tps. 27 and 28 N, Rs 35 and 36 E., with a brass cap, marked.

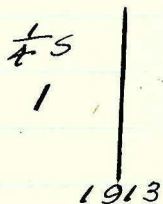


dig pits 24x24x12 ins., on each line N., E., and W., 4 ft. and 5. of post, 8 ft. dist; and raise a mound of earth, 5 ft. base, 2 1/2 ft. high S. of cor. The range line bears N 0° 05' W

Thence I resurvey 50° 05' E, bet secs 1 and 6 over level ground, through old lake bed.

dig pits 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft dist, and raise a mound of earth, 3 1/2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, N. of cor.
